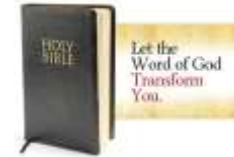


Cold & flu season is upon us! Kittrell School is in need of facial tissues for all their wonderful students! Please leave them in the pew downstairs. Thanks!

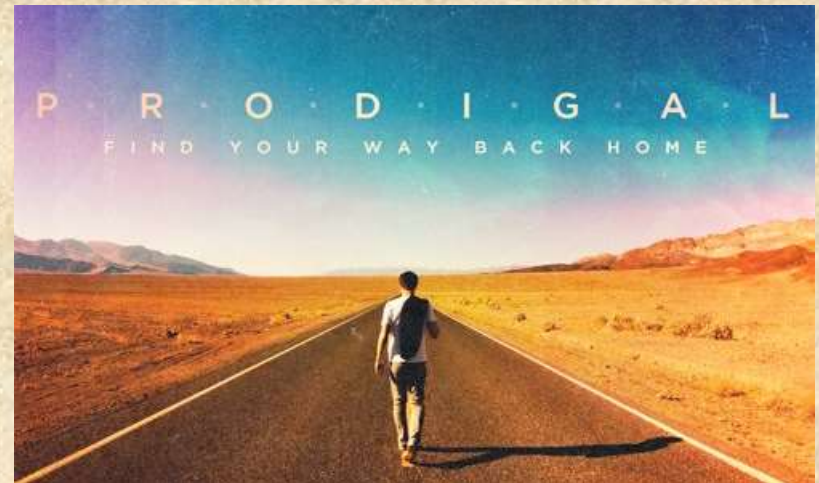

Luke 15:11-24 (NIV) “Jesus continued: “There was a man who had two sons.
